

## What.Do.You.Think? ONLINE COURSE EVALUATION STUDENT INSTRUCTIONS

### Log In

1. In your web browser, navigate to: [wdyt.hartford.edu](http://wdyt.hartford.edu).
  - a. For a list of supported browsers please visit [https://www.applyweb.com/browser\\_support/index.ftl](https://www.applyweb.com/browser_support/index.ftl)
2. Log in to the system using your University of Hartford email username, password, and your university ID number
3. You will be redirected to your home page for What.Do.You.Think? (see image below.)



### Home Page

- From your home page you will see a list of courses for which you need to submit your evaluations, and the deadline for completing evaluations
- The status for each course will update as you complete each evaluation

## Evaluations

- When you start an evaluation you will be taken to the Evaluation page which lists the university's general course questions and any additional questions that a specific school or department includes for that course
- If an instructor has added additional questions they will be included on page 2 of the evaluation.
- Once you have answered all the questions, select NEXT at the bottom of the page. You will be given a chance to review your questions, or select FINISH to submit your evaluation
- If you need more time to complete an evaluation, you can, at any point, select SAVE. This will allow you to log in at a later time to continue your evaluation. The system will remember where you left off so you can complete the evaluation. You only need to use the SAVE button for this purpose.

## Troubleshooting

- What.Do.You.Think? is being supported by a system administrator reporting to the Office of the Provost. If the helpdesk staff cannot resolve the issue it will be forwarded to the system administrator.
